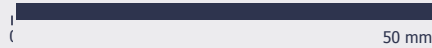


HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR WRIST SIZE

Please carefully read all instructions as the measurement may not be accurate if not done properly.

1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "none" on your print dialog box.
2. Measure the bar on the right to ensure it is exactly 2 inches or 50 mm long.
3. If measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size (100%) and reprint before continuing.



Standard bracelet sizes

The standard bracelet size for women is 7" (17,78 cm) and the standard bracelet size for men is 8" (20,32 cm). This varies on the style and the manufacturer. We will contact you if your wrist size does not match the standard size.

Measuring your wrist size

For customers who believe that their wrist size may be outside of the standard range for bracelets, a soft seamstress-style measuring tape can be used to provide an approximate measurement of the wrist.

Not sure where to measure on your wrist?

You simply print out the size tool, cut it out, and tape it together to form a measuring tape. Then you simply wrap it around your wrist at the wrist bone and mark where it meets to get your approximate wrist measurement. Usually, wrists at or within 3 inches (7,6 cm) less than the standard bracelet diameter will fit most standard bracelets.

Determining your approximate bracelet size range

After you have measured the basic diameter of your wrist, add 1cm to that measurement in order to give you some movement and flexibility. Remember that some bracelets fit differently. This measurement should be within the size range of the bracelet. Note that depending on the style of clasp; some give you a trifle more space. Also, if the beads, pearls, gemstones or other adornments are very large, the room for your wrist may decrease.

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
